## ATTESTATION

On behalf of the firm Fa-Ma Jersey S.p.a., Head quarters in Italy, via B. Buozzi, 13, PRATO,  
I have carried out allergological tests on the following product in order to establish the skin tolerability and allergenic potential :

### **"BABY-BIO" wet-wipes**

Composed, in accordance with the certification of the producer, by Maspun 508020PLA (80% Viscosa, 20% Polylactic acid, 50g/mq), umidified by "BIO" solution.

In accordance with document giving guide-lines for trials of skin compatibility, the evaluation of irritation and sensitisation properties of cosmetic products (Applying CEE normative) released by the third commission of the Cosmetic Study Group of the "Consiglio Superiore della Sanità" (Italian Health Department), we have made the following test :

- **Repeated Open Application Test (R.O.A.T.)** (according to Hannuksela M. and Salo H. Contact Dermatitis. 1986;14:221-7) for evaluation of allergic and irritancy potential.

25 healthy volunteers used the wet wipes twice a day, on the skin surface of forearm (inner arm fold) for one week. All the volunteers were controlled daily for 7 days. After 3 weeks the same volunteers applied the wet wipes twice daily, open, as before on their forearm for other seven days. Finally they were evaluated in order to determine whether daily application caused allergic sensitization. We supply the details of the testification (details of volunteers, test time and results).

**The performed Open tests in all 25 cases have given negative response, without response of allergic type (specific reaction) and of irritative type (aspecific response).**

**We can thereby assume that the product in question has excellent tolerability and does not cause allergic sensitization.**
