

CERTIFICATE

As requested, we have examined the pulp grade "Air-Laid Grade, Biobright TR" produced by the company Rauma Cell. The examination aimed at establishing whether the pulp grade concerned, in respect of its purity, is suitable as raw material for food packages.

By judging the suitability we refer to the following regulations:

Recommendation XXXVI (latest revised on June 1, 1999) issued by BgVV in Germany (previously BGA, Bundesgesundheitsamt, Germany).

Recommendation XXXVI/2 (latest revised on June 1, 1998) issued by BgVV in Germany (previously BGA, Bundesgesundheitsamt, Germany).

Code of Federal Regulations, CFR, Title 21, Food and Drug Administration, FDA (revised as of April 1, 1999), Parts 170-189, particularly to § 186.1673 "Pulp".

Samples of the pulp were tested sensorically. The results indicate that the pulp tested is not inclined to bring about a deterioration in the organoleptic characteristics of food being in contact with the pulp.

The microbiological purity of the above pulp was also tested using methods ISO 8784-1:1987 and DIN 54378. The pulp was found to be microbiologically pure.

We are fully acquainted with the processes used for the manufacturing of the virgin pulp grade in question. It is produced under conditions of good manufacturing practice with paying attention also to the possible use as a component of food packaging materials.

According to our judgement the pulp grade mentioned above may be used as a raw material of food packages in compliance with the regulations referred to above.
